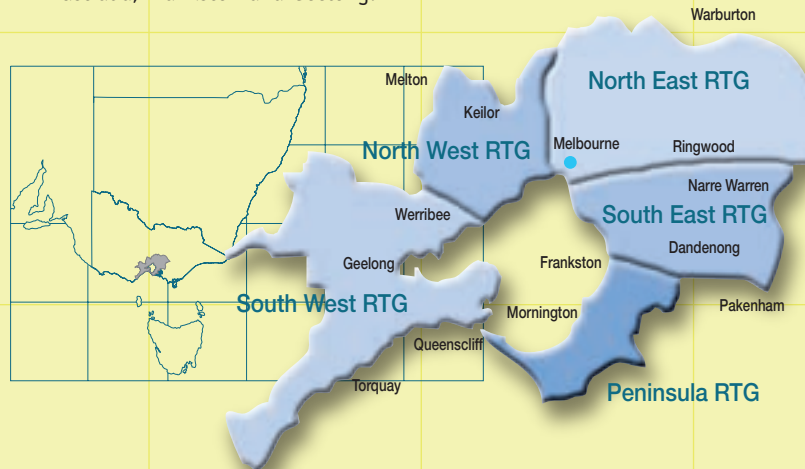

The geographic region

VMA General Practice Training is positioned around Port Phillip Bay, extending from the Bellarine Peninsula, through the Melbourne metropolitan region to the Mornington Peninsula. To ensure specific regional needs and issues are acknowledged and taken into account the VMA has divided this area into five Regional Training Groups (RTG's) covering the North Eastern, South Eastern, Peninsula, North Western and South Western regions of the consortium. Each region has the opportunity to implement specific projects and initiatives within a centrally administered framework.

Major centres include Melbourne, the second largest city in Australia, Frankston and Geelong.
